ORDER

Pursuant to the Opinion issued by the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit on October 2, 2017, this Court has reconsidered Defendant Charles Tyrone Walker's motions to terminate the fine imposed as part of his sentence. Applying the version of 18 U.S.C. § 3613(b) that existed at the time Mr. Walker was sentenced in 1995, the Court finds that more than 20 years have elapsed after the entry of the judgment and that the fine has therefore expired. See 18 U.S.C. § 3613(b) (1994). Accordingly, the Court **GRANTS** Defendant Walker's motions to terminate the fine [Doc. Nos. 503, 504].
